Community Control: If Not Us, Then Who?

A strong community doesn't just happen by chance. It's built by people who choose to be involved, who understand that every decision matters, and who know that doing nothing is still a choice. Community control starts when we stop waiting on someone else to fix things and accept a simple truth: no one is coming to save us. We have to step up and shape our own future.

Commitment isn't just a feeling, it's about showing up and putting in the work. It's being there even when it's inconvenient, standing your ground when things get tough, and doing what you said you would do, even when no one's watching. It's about looking out for each other, protecting what matters, and not walking away from our responsibilities. Community control isn't about power over others, it's about taking ownership. It's choosing to build something better through unity, knowledge, and real action.

Everyone has a role to play, and no one can pass that off to someone else. Some people will mentor the youth. Others will organize, teach, build, protect, or create. Whether it's through guidance, education, financial support, or just showing care, every effort adds up. There's no such thing as a role that's too small, only effort that's either given or not.

But it doesn't stop with what we do individually. It also shows up in how we spend our money, who we support, and what we choose to prioritize. Those decisions either help build our community up or slowly tear it down. If what we do doesn't match what we say we believe in, then we're not really committed.

We can also see what happens when we don't support our own. We spend our money in places that don't give back to us, while those same dollars help strengthen communities that look out for themselves first. That sends a message to the next generation: support everyone else before yourself, give to people who don't value you, and accept disrespect. We have to be honest about that and think about where it leads. How can we say we're in control of our future if we don't build or maintain anything within it?

Taking control of our community means protecting what makes it ours. It's about keeping our history alive, standing on our values, handling conflict with wisdom, and living in a way that sets the right example. Children don't just listen to what we say, they watch what we do. What we live is what they learn.

A community's strength shows in how consistent its people are. When everyone takes responsibility, even small actions start to add up and create real change. It doesn't happen overnight, it grows through individuals, families, and neighborhoods until it becomes something undeniable.

As Malcolm X said, "The future belongs to those who prepare for it today." So the real question isn't what anyone else is going to do. It's simple: what are you going to do, right now, to help build something better for all of us? If Not Us, Then Who?

REFORM THROUGH CULTURE: HOW THE NATION OF GODS AND EARTHS OF SAVIOR CEE ARE HELPING MAKE CHANGE IN PRISON POLICY, PAROLE ADVOCACY, AND COMMUNITY-BASED REHABILITATION IN SAVIOR CEE.



Peace Family! Prison Reform is one of Savior Cee's primary initiatives for 2026, and it will remain a priority for as long as we have brothers and sisters behind the wall. We move as one mind and one body, never abandoning or forgetting our own. Our incarcerated brothers and sisters are still part of us, still deserving of dignity, advocacy, and cultural protection. In a system designed to silence and dehumanize them, we stand as their voice. We work to ensure they receive their basic needs, fair treatment, just trials, equitable parole hearings, and the right to live and express their culture as Gods and Earths.



In Savior Cee, this commitment is active work carried out by dedicated Gods and Earths who stand firmly on cultural duty and collective responsibility. Across the state, we engage in initiatives that strengthen advocacy, expand access, and protect the cultural rights of our people behind the wall. This includes years of work with SCDC to secure proper recognition of the Nation of Gods and Earths and the right to express our way of life through Understanding Self Allah and I Wisdom Understanding Earth.



This progress did not come easily. It took years of pressure, administrative challenges, and court proceedings where our people were forced to defend their identity against mislabeling and resistance. Many endured long stretches in lock-up, isolation, and retaliation simply because they refused to renounce who they are. Understanding Self Allah is one of those who paid that price, standing firm through sacrifice and targeted pressure because he would not compromise his foundation. His struggle, and the struggle of many others, is the reason this moment exists.



As Understanding Self Allah expressed so powerfully: "The recognition of the Nation of Gods and Earths within SCDC is more than a policy update, it is an overdue acknowledgment of a people who refused to bend. It affirms the right to live, study, and express our culture without fear. This victory was earned through persistence, consistency, and unwavering wisdom. Understanding Self Allah refused to accept 'no' as final and pushed until what was right and exact was recognized. I know this because I am Understanding Self Allah's Earth. There may be naysayers, b.u.t. we know mathematics, and mathematics is order. What we witness today is the result of applied knowledge, disciplined wisdom, and the refusal to allow disorder to define our culture."



Our work does not end with cultural recognition. We also stand behind the SCDC Parole, Probation, and Pardon petition led by Yaa Majesty Earth, calling for evidence-based reform and fair review practices. The petition demands licensed mental health professionals on every parole board so decisions are guided by clinical expertise, not assumption. It also calls for interim parole hearings to fast-track individuals who clearly meet release criteria, reducing unnecessary denials, easing overcrowding, and saving taxpayer dollars. Justice requires expertise, and real efficiency requires reform.



Our commitment extends into the community as well. Street Justice, guided by Precious Jewel Earth, empowers redemption, reentry, and rehabilitation for those affected by mass incarceration. Their hands-on work includes reentry support, housing assistance, job placement, transportation, credit repair, financial literacy, business guidance, and ongoing advocacy. Street Justice fills the gaps left by the system, ensuring our people return home to structure, opportunity, and dignity.



We also honor the work of Just Move Universal Outreach, founded by Crown Mega Allah and C-Wise Allah, operating in Orangeburg and the Lowcountry. Their mission includes providing necessities of life, advancing prison and social reform, and supporting at-risk women and children. In Charleston, Crown and his team hold weekly mentoring sessions that offer young people a safe space to express themselves and learn how to redirect their energy toward positive outcomes. In the Midlands, the organization partners with schools to provide consistent mentoring, while C-Wise Allah and his team sponsor community events that promote unity, awareness, and collective responsibility.



Together, these efforts form a unified movement rooted in knowledge of self, cultural duty, and the unwavering commitment to uplift our people on every front. From securing recognition within SCDC, to demanding fair parole practices, to building community-centered support systems, we show what real reform looks like when driven by those most affected. The progress we see today is the result of sacrifice, advocacy, and collective discipline. Our responsibility now is to continue this momentum, strengthen these foundations, and ensure every victory becomes a stepping stone for those who follow. The struggle is not over, b.u.t. neither is our resolve. We will keep building, keep teaching, and keep advancing until justice and cultural truth are not exceptions in South Carolina, they are standard. **Peace.**
