REFORM THREATENS REVENUE. THAT IS WHY THE SYSTEM RESISTS IT.



Prison reform is no longer a distant policy debate, it is an urgent matter that directly impacts our families, our neighborhoods, and the future of Black and Brown communities...

From the roots of slave patrols to the discriminatory laws of Jim Crow, to today's biased policing and sentencing practices, the criminal justice system has consistently treated Black and Brown bodies as commodities, not citizens. Our communities are over-policed, underfunded, and unfairly punished. Poverty is criminalized. Mental illness is criminalized. Even our very presence is seen as a "threat."

NOT ACCIDENTAL. NOT COINCIDENTAL. STRUCTURAL DESIGN!

America's prison system is tied to a multibillion-dollar industry. Corporations profit from:

- overcrowding
- longer sentences
- cheap prison labor
- high phone rates
- commissary contracts
- medical and food service deals
- private prisons with bed quotas

Greed is the engine behind non-reform! The system cannot afford for our people to grow... Healed people don't fill prison beds. Educated people... Targets. Empowered people... Profit. Reform threatens revenue, and that is why the system resists it.

The cost of staying silent if we continue to do nothing, are already clear:

- More families torn apart
- More children growing up without parents
- More communities disrupted
- More poverty, trauma, and stigma

True reform is not shallow promises... community-centered:

1. **Rehabilitation Over Punishment:** Education, skill-building, therapy... strict confinement.
2. **Ending Predatory Sentencing and Cash Bail:** Mandatory minimums, unfair plea deals... punish poverty.
3. **Fair Policing and Accountability:** Black and Brown people... hunting grounds.
4. **Restorative Justice Models:** Healing, not destruction...
5. **Strong Reentry Programs:** Stable housing, job pathways, counseling... not a bus ticket and a trash bag.
6. **Ending Profit from Punishment:** No corporation... human suffering.

Reform is possible, but only if we push...

1. **Get Vocal:** stop whispering... town halls, social media, mosques...
2. **Elect Representatives Who Truly Represent Us:** decarceration, not empty promises... lip service.
3. **Build Coalitions:** families, activists, educators... collective power.
4. **Educate Ourselves and Our Youth:** tools to dismantle it.
5. **Support Those Still Inside:** letters, donate books, send love... dignity and hope.

Prison reform is not optional... Not a political favor, it is a moral mandate. Remember, our adversaries work around the clock. So must we!

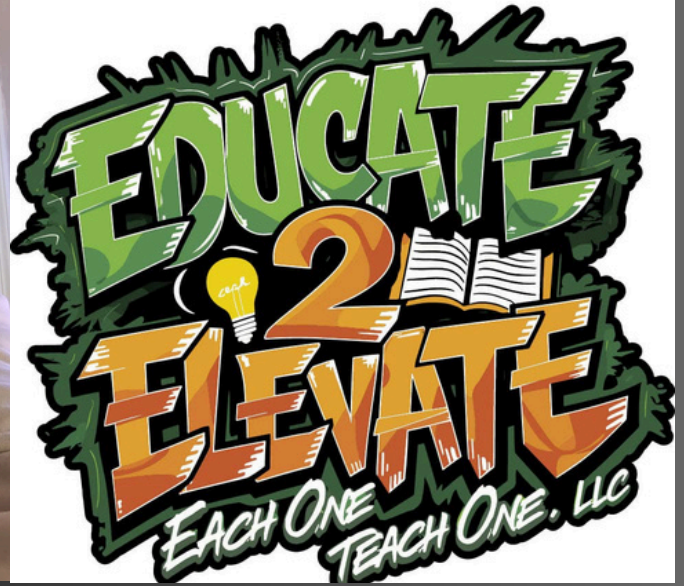

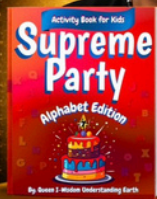

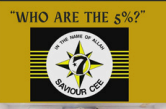
