


Queen I-Wisdom Understanding Earth:



Star's Corner Activity: "BUDGET!"

This activity can be done at home, class, or Parliament.

Materials Needed

- Paper
- Pencil or crayons
- Play money or a written amount (example: \$10 or \$20)
- A list or pictures of common items (needs and wants)



Stars are given a list (or pictures) of items and must decide whether each one is a Need or a Want. After sorting, they create a simple budget using only a set amount of money.

Example Items:

Food, rent, school supplies, toys, video games, clothes, snacks, phone, savings

Purpose of the Activity:

- To help children understand the difference between needs and wants
- To teach decision-making when money is limited
- To introduce real-life budgeting choices in a safe, age-appropriate way

Expected Lesson

- Money must be planned, not spent randomly
- Needs should be handled before wants
- Budgeting requires thinking ahead and making choices
- Every choice has a result or consequence
- Learn that money is limited
- Planning helps avoid waste

DID YOU KNOW?


Did you know the first Black-owned bank in South Carolina was Victory Savings Bank, founded in 1921 in Columbia?

At a time when most banks refused to serve Black citizens, Victory Savings Bank was created out of necessity, vision, and collective self-reliance. It provided a safe place for Black families and businesses to save money, secure loans, buy property, and build economic stability when exclusion from white financial institutions was the norm.


This bank was more than a financial institution, it was a tool of protection and progress. It helped circulate dollars within the community, supported Black entrepreneurship, and laid a foundation for generational wealth in South Carolina. The legacy of Victory Savings Bank lives on today as Optus Bank, continuing to serve underserved communities.

Why This Knowledge Matters

Understanding this history reminds us that access to financial systems has never been equal, and that Black communities have always organized to meet their own needs when shut out. Knowing about institutions like Victory Savings Bank teaches us: why community banking matters, how economic independence supports freedom, that wealth building is intentional, not accidental and the importance of knowing where and how we bank.
